There is a written examination, set by the IRCA, on the last day of the course, in addition to continuous assessment based on the practical exercises as well as the work and contribution during the course.

Delegates, who succeed in passing both the continuous assessment and the examination shall be eligible for registration as a Provisional Auditor on condition of meeting the IRCA requirements within 3 years of passing the course. DAS Pakistan & STCI will assist the top five successful participants to complete the requirements of IRCA for auditing from each course.

Prior to the commencement of the course, all delegates are expected to have some understanding of the contents and implementation of the ISO 14000:2004 Standards. Copy of ISO 14000 Standards and Training Manual can be obtained from STCI office after the nomination is confirmed.
